## Saving a Selected Element

You can save out a selection as an individual file. This is a great way to build your own library of favorite elements. You can add these elements to the *My Scrapbooking* dialog box.

To save an individual selection to your own library, perform the following steps:

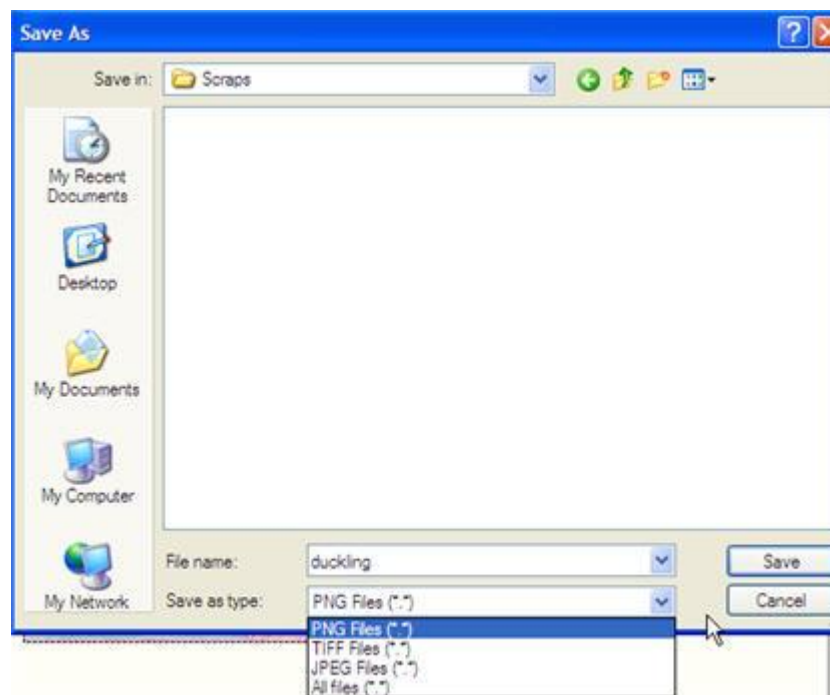
1. Select an item on a page.
2. Right-click the item.
3. From the menu, select **Save Selection**.



**Note:** The copyright notice appears when you are saving a selection that is copyrighted. You can still save the item. However, the copyright imposes a restriction that you can only use the item within the software. Often, the copyright notice will occur when you are working with elements or modified elements originally part of a downloaded package.



4. The Save As dialog box appears. You can save your item in any location. If you want to save your item to your personal scrapbooking library, browse to *C:\MyDocuments\Creative Memories\My Scrapbooking Stuff*.
5. Select the collection to which you want to add the object. To learn about creating collections, refer to Art Ribbon: Using My Scrapbooking Stuff.
6. Decide whether the element is a paper or a scrap. A scrap is everything but a paper, including shapes and images.
7. Choose the file type from the drop-down menu. The default selection is PNG.



8. Click **Save**. The item has been saved to your computer. You can now access this element from any project.

**Tip:** To access your Scrapbooking Stuff, you can click **My Scrapbooking Stuff** on the Art ribbon. You can also click Organize at the bottom of the Embellishments and Papers panels.
