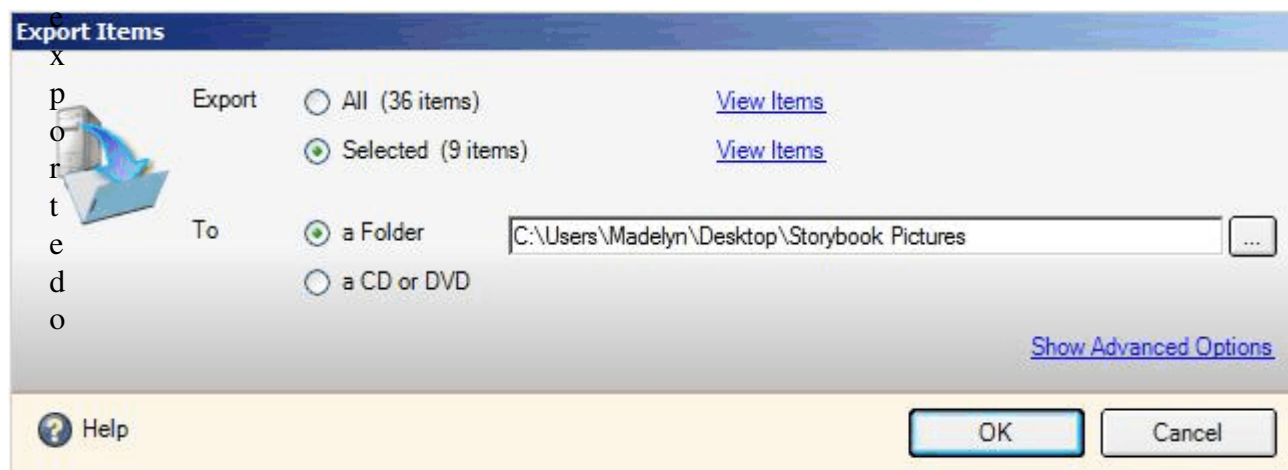



How to get additional photos from Memory Manager into an ongoing project in Storybook Creator:

Note: If you have NOT created the album project in Storybook Creator, you can simply select your photos in Memory Manager and select *Share* from the main menu and select *Create a Storybook*. It will take the photos right to Storybook Creator and start up the program where you can *Create a new project* and select the album you want and begin.

If you HAVE already created the album then do the following....

1. The first thing you need to do is to create a “temporary holding folder” on your desktop. I named my folder *Storybook Pictures*. To make a folder, right click on your desktop and select *New* and then *Folder* and give it a name. (If you haven’t created this folder when you’re ready to export, you can type in the folder name in the *Export Items* window within Memory Manager--shown below--and it will ask if you want to create it where you can select *Yes*).
2. In Memory Manager, select the photos you’d like. If you’re getting photos from several different folders, you’ll need to use the clipboard. Otherwise, just select the photos from the current folder or from the main media library.
3. With the photos selected, select *Share* from the main menu (or *Share* from the clipboard).
4. Select *Export*. It will then bring up the Export window asking if you want all the pictures



or the ones you have selected. It will have the location of the last time you saved. Click on the *browse* button  and go to your desktop to find the folder you just created. It will stay that way until you change it.

5. Click OK and they will be exported into that folder.
6. Now go into Storybook Creator and go to *Photo* on the main menu or go to your *Photos* and select *Get Photos*.
7. The *Which Photo(s) do you want to get?* screen displays, Click on the folder (under desktop) containing the photos you just exported.
8. Get *all* the photos or *get selected* photos. To select a series, click on the first photo, then hold down the shift key and click on the last photo and it will select that series. If you want to select random photos, use the *Ctrl* key to select the photos you’d like.
9. Once they’re in Storybook Creator Plus, get in the habit of going back to your desktop folder to clean out those photos. If you use “*shift delete*” it will delete them permanently, bypassing your recycle bin.

FYI: When in the *Export* screen in Memory Manager, you can select the *Help* menu in the lower left side for additional helps on Exporting such as how to save to CD/DVD, etc.
